- From the south: Follow the N3, until you pass Estcourt. Take the Estcourt North/Exit 179/Loskop turnoff to your left (just past the Wembezi/Giant's Castle Exit 175). Turn left towards Loskop. Stay on this road (ap-

left onto the R600 (Thokozisa is on the corner on your

left on the Bergville/Oliviershoek Pass road. Continue past Sterkfontein Dam, down Oliviershoek Pass, towards Bergville and Winterton. At Winterton, turn right onto the R600, CENTRAL BERG road. Continue for approx 13 km to the crossroad, go straight past Thokozisa which is on the left, continue along this road for approx 20-30 minutes - Monks Cowl is at the

end of this road.
